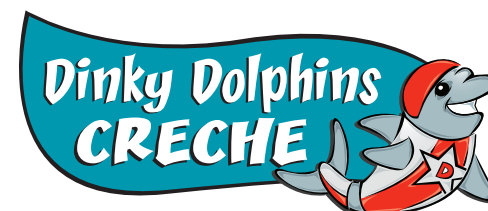

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ABOUT US

Dinky Dolphins Crèche is a custom built supervised children's play room that has been designed specifically to provide a safe, fun environment for children.

This is a supervised play area that provides for children's entertainment. It is not an alternative to baby sitting or childcare facilities.

The centre is located at the entry of Dolphins Health Precinct. It is fully equipped to cater for children from 8 weeks of age to 12 years and is staffed by dedicated carers that you can trust.

Booking and Fees

You may book your child in for up to a two hour visit. A small fee applies and members can pay conveniently through fortnightly direct debit. A reduction in fee's applied for additional siblings.

Places are limited and bookings are essential to avoid disappointment. Booking can only be made one week in advance.

This brochure is a guide to terms and conditions of use and hours of operation. The Dinky Dolphins Crèche registration form outlines these conditions more thoroughly. We ask you to read it if you are considering bringing your child for a visit.

Initial Visit

Prior to your initial visit a registration form must be completed for each child.



Daily Procedures

- ➔ On each visit the child/children must be signed in and out by the same person. If for any reason the collecting person differs - a consent form must be completed upon entry.
- ➔ The registering parent/guardian must remain on the Dolphins Health Precinct premises at all times.
- ➔ If your child becomes upset or distressed at any time you will be asked to return immediately. Should your child display unacceptable behaviour you will be asked to return immediately to attend to your child.



Food and Drink

No food is to be brought into the Crèche. Feeding bottles and drink bottles are allowed, but must be clearly labelled with your child's full name.



Nappy Policy

Parents must change the child's nappy upon arrival. Consent is required for staff to change any nappies during your booking and parents must supply disposable nappies.



Sickness

It is the responsibility of parents not to admit children to Dinky Dolphins Crèche when they are sick. Staff have the right to refuse entry as they see fit.
